GRAND RAPIDS, Mich. November 21, 2016—Suburban Inns broke ground today on the development of a new sports bar and grill at 2325 East Beltline, just north of Woodland Mall.

Big E's on the East Beltline is being constructed adjacent to the Hilton Garden Inn, also owned band operated by Suburban Inns. The hotel is currently under construction. Both the hotel and Big E's are expected to open in early 2017.
